Crews on gate duty are representing Rovers to everyone who passes through the gate. There is an expectation that crews are .00BAC for their gate duty shift, as they must be competent to do their job, and also must make a good impression to entering visitors.

At the very least the minimum number of four (4) crew members are required at the front gate, with the exceptions of Friday Night (4pm – 11.59pm) and on Mudbash Open Day (Sunday 8am – 12pm) where there must be at least 6 crew members present.

No alcohol is to be consumed at the front gate. It is the Crew Leaders responsibility to ensure that no crew members are drunk or abusive at the front gate. Crews failing to do so may face repercussions at the Chairpersons discretion.
