

**Rover Scout Motorsport**  
**Administration Policy**  
**CLUBMAN AWARD**

This policy covers the selection process and awarding of the Rover Scout Motorsport Clubman of the Year Award, otherwise known as the RSM Clubman Award.

**Award Description:**

The Rover Scout Motorsport Clubman of the Year Award is awarded to an individual of Rover age who has displayed exceptional sportsmanship which in turn promotes and enhances Rover Scout Motorsport.

**Award Criteria:**

The criteria for Nominees are as follows:

- Must be a Rover and under the age of 26,
- Demonstrates values of fair play and equality,
- Demonstrates exceptional sportsmanship,
- Be an excellent ambassador for Rovers and Rover Scout Motorsport in the eyes of Club Members and outside personnel alike,
- Be an active member of the club across a number of events.

**Nomination Process:**

Only Completed Nomination Forms will be accepted and they must be sent to the RSM Committee via one of two methods by the last Friday of JULY.
