ADMINISTRATION POLICY
NON-ROVER MEMBERSHIP

This policy outlines the process for the issuing of RSM Membership to Non-Rover Section Scouts Australia – Victorian Branch Members by the RSM Committee and the conditions attached to the issuing of RSM Membership.

Anyone competing in a Club Level event run by RSM must become a member of Rover Scout Motorsport. Unless otherwise exempted, any member of RSM must be a member of the Scouts Australia.

Process:

The following is required from a person making an application to become an RSM member:

- Must provide proof they are a member of the Scouts Australia – by letter from their Group Leader or via Extranet.
 - Non Rover Definitions:
Over 26 years of age,
Registered Member of Scouts Australia - Victorian Branch
Recognised involvements:
Australian Scout Fellowship
Section Leadership Role (Joey Scouts, Cub Scouts, Scouts, Venturer Scouts, Activities Team, etc.)
- CAMS license must be in date.
- The person must fill in an RSM Membership Application Form with all the required details.
- A fee of \$25 required upon application (flat fee) not applicable to warranted leaders.
 - Your registered role will be checked at census or upon application.
- The application is approved by the RSM Chairman, RSM Vice Chairman or RSM Secretary.
- Once the application is approved the person shall be issued with a membership card expiring 30th June of that calendar year.
- A receipt shall be issued for the monies collected.
- The membership application form shall be kept by RSM and a register of members shall be kept detailing all information on the form.

Conditions:

All RSM Memberships terminate on 30th June of the current financial year regardless of purchase date.
