## 4. AUTHORITY

The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) Ltd, the Khanacross Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, which may be issued by RSM.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)

## 5. PLACE AND DATE

The Event will be held at Mafeking Rover Park from Saturday 13 October 2018 to Sunday 14 October 2018.

## 6. ENTRIES

Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close at 5:00pm 5<sup>th</sup> October 2018. An entry will only be deemed valid when payment is received with a completed and RSM Entry Form. All Drivers must hold a minimum of a CAMS level 2NS/2NSJ License or superior. A maximum of eight Drivers per vehicle will be accepted.

Entry Fee is \$70 per person for entries received by 5:00pm 5<sup>th</sup> October 2018. A late Entry Fee of \$30 per Driver will apply for entries received after 9:00am 5<sup>th</sup> October 2018.

A maximum number of Entries is 100. Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

## 7. PRE-EVENT PAPERWORK

All Competitors/Drivers must present their current CAMS license to the paperwork checker at the Secretary's desk prior to having their vehicles Scrutineered.

## 8. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual.

## 9. SCRUTINY

Scrutiny will be at the Mafeking Rover Park. Scrutiny will commence at 8:00am on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> October. Vehicles will only be Scrutineered **AFTER COMPLETING PRE-EVENT PAPERWORK**. CAMS vehicle Log Book (if issued) & competition attire for all Drivers must be presented with vehicle. Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D

of the current CAMS Manual.

## 10. DRIVERS BRIEFING

It is compulsory for all Drivers and Passengers to attend the Driver Briefing on the day of the disciplines. Any Driver who misses the Briefing will be ineligible to drive for the sessions following the briefing. Driver Briefing times are outlined in the Event Schedule. The Khanacross test sighting lap may follow after this Briefing.

## 11. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)

## 12. CLASSES:

<b>LADIES:</b>	Any female regardless of age

## 13. SPECIAL NOTES

- Any breaches of these Supplementary Regulations will be dealt with in the same manner as a breach of all other Regulations pertaining to the Event.
- Competitors must have two members in the vehicle during competition. Both members must hold a L2NS or superior CAMS licence.
- Traveling speed away from the competition area will be walking pace only, this includes approaching and leaving start and stop garages.
- Fire extinguishers as per Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport must be securely fitted to the vehicle.
- Safety helmets must conform to CAMS requirements (eg AS1698) and be worn whilst competing.
- All Competitors are required to wear snug fitting clothes covering the body from neck to wrist to ankles and suitable footwear. Clothing should be of a fire resistant nature.
- All vehicles must be adequately muffled. Noise limit is 95dB.
- Penalties as per Khanacross regulations.
- No car is to be started before 9:00am. All cars must be off by 10:15pm.
- All Crew must provide two members for Marshalling over the weekend.
- Vehicles must be clean and no foreign plant or earth matter must enter Mafeking Rover Park. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the Event.
- Oil cap to be gold.
- A \$50 deposit (cash only), is to be paid to the Event Secretary upon sign in. Please place the deposit in an unsealed envelope with Crew name and Crew contact number clearly written on the front. The deposit will be returned to the Crew on Sunday, once camping and pit bays have been cleared by the Event director.
- Dash for cash results will be separate to the Event. \$10 per run with no limits on amount of times entered. 1<sup>st</sup> Place takes Home all the prize money up to \$100 the remaining goes to Firefighter's Charity Fund. 2<sup>nd</sup> Place receives 1 free Driver's ticket to Winter Challenge 2018 (excluding catering).

## 14. COURSE

The course surface is dirt/gravel. A minimum of 6 and a maximum of 30 tests will be conducted. The Khanacross course shall apply to that individual path and combination of maneuvers, as per Khanacross requirements, in the prescribed manner.

## 15. RUNNING DETAIL

Khanacross results will be calculated on the total of elapsed times to complete the tests nominated by the director and any penalties. The winner shall be the Driver/crew having the lowest total. Timing will be by handheld stopwatches or other means.

## 16. TERMINATION

The organizers reserve the right to stop the Event at any time if they consider it necessary, in the interests of safety or for any other reason. In case of a Day of Total Fire Ban **NO ACTIVITY**, practice included, will be allowed.

## 17. POSTPONEMENT OR ABANDONMENT

The organizers reserve the right to postpone, abandon, or cancel the Event under NCR 59, and if the Event is cancelled or postponed for more than 24 hours, the entry fees shall be refunded in full.

## 18. AWARDS

1st in each class –Trophy. Outright 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd – Trophy

## 19. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another

ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

**20. NOISE**

Vehicles must be ADEQUATELY muffled and not exceed a noise limit of 95dB(A).

**21. PROTESTS**

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

**22. FUEL**

Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

**23. PASSENGERS AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY**

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy. Passengers are only allowed where their role is as an 'Instructor'.

- (a) A Briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Instructors must:
  - i. Be experienced and have the permission of the Clerk of the Course. The suitability of the Passenger is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
  - ii. Wear the same protective gear as a Driver in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
  - iii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes.
  - iv. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer.
  - v. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger.
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.

- the risks associated with attending or participating in Motor Sport Activities include but are **NOT LIMITED** to the risk that I may suffer harm as a result of:
  - motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property;
  - others participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
  - high levels of noise exposure;
  - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
  - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

**EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY**

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, I **agree**:

- to **release** CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
  - a) my **death**;
  - b) any **physical or mental injury** (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
  - c) the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a **disease**;
  - d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other **condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs**:
    - i. that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
    - ii. that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community, howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;

- to **indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified** the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and

to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities **at my own risk**. I **understand** that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of the Entities as the supplier of the Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and

Under the Australian Consumer Law (Victoria), several statutory guarantees apply to the supply of certain goods and services. These guarantees mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you:

- are rendered with due care and skill;
- are reasonably fit for any purpose which you either expressly or by implication, make known to the supplier; and
- might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.
