SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Event

- a) The event is a closed club non speed event. It will consist of a series of Khanacross & Motorkhana tests. The Event is open to Rover Scout Motorsport members only, and will hereafter be referred to as the Event. The event permit number is: 318/1103/02
- b) The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au.
- c) This event is also round 2 for the club level Rover Scout Motorsport Championship Series 2017/18.

2. Key Personnel

3. Authority

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport, the Khanacross Regulations, the National Motorkhana Code, Rover Scout Motorsport Standing Regulations, the event supplementary regulations and any further regulations that may be issued.

4. Place and Date

The event will be conducted at Tapio Station, Arumpo Road, Arumpo NSW, 10th-11th March 2018. The surface is dirt.

5. Entries

- a) Entries will open on the publication of these regulations and close at 7pm on Friday 2nd March 2018. Entries received after this date will be charged an additional Late Fee of \$30 per Driver.
- b) Entries will only be accepted by persons who are financial members of Rover Scout Motorsport.
- c) CAMS licences, club memberships and vehicle logbooks (if issued) for ALL crew members must be presented at Check In.
- d) The competitive & passenger entry cost is included in event tickets purchased at <http://border-bash.com/>. Tickets priced at \$110 for pre-sold, \$140 for gate tickets.
- e) The maximum number of entries will be 50 teams or 160 Drivers (Whichever is reached first) accepted in order of receipt.
- f) Entry forms are to be completed in full, including signatures and must be accompanied with the entry fee when returned to the event secretary, prior to the closing date to be considered valid.

Note: *Incomplete Forms will be classed as incomplete entries and Late Fees will be applicable. No competition will take place for any team until ALL documentation is complete and money paid.*

- g) The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR83.

6. Insurance

- a) Public risk insurance has been affected by the promoters, through CAMS.
- b) All drivers, passengers and signed on officials are covered by the motor sport personal accident policy as per Appendix I of the 2017 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

7. Classes

There are 2 classes: Class 1: Rovers
 Class 2: Other RSM Members (Non-Rovers)

8. Starting Order

- a) There will be no set starting order for any discipline.
- b) Driver Numbers are used for scoring reference only.

9. Crew Members

- a) All drivers, passengers and crew members that are participating in the competition must be the holder of at least a CAMS level 2NS competition licence.
- b) Two persons are required in the vehicle whilst competing unless approved by the Clerk Of Course.

10. Driver's Briefing

- a) It is compulsory for all drivers and passengers to attend the driver briefing on the day of the disciplines. Any driver who misses the briefing will be ineligible to drive on the day.
- b) The briefings will be conducted at the Main Eating Shelter, at 9am on Saturday 10th & at 9am on Sunday 11th March 2018.

11. Scrutiny

- a) Scrutiny will take place in the Event Pits Area on Friday 9th March 2018 from 9pm until 10pm and Saturday 10th March 2018 from 7.00am to 8.30am.
- b) All competing vehicles must comply with Schedules A and B and Group 4H of the CAMS Manual, the Rover Scout Motorsport Event and Vehicle Standing Regulations.
- c) Crews are reminded to present their vehicles in full competition trim (except for tyres but including safety equipment and driving lights).
- d) Vehicles must be presented at scrutiny and the event start in a clean and tidy condition. Vehicles deemed not to comply with this requirement by the scrutineers or Clerk of Course will not be scrutineered or allowed to start the event as appropriate.
- e) All competing vehicles must pass scrutiny to start the event. Those competitors requiring re-scrutiny must make their own arrangements for appropriate checking prior to the event.
- f) The Event Scrutineers are deemed to be Judges of Fact with regard to scrutiny matters.
- g) Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.
- h) Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.
- i) Driver apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.
- j) All vehicles must have completed the yearly vehicle inspection by Rover Scout Motorsport (VIC). Alternatively, an inspection may be conducted by a CAMS Scrutineer for teams residing more than three hours from Melbourne. To access this option, you must contact the Rover Scout Motorsport (VIC) Chief Scrutineer on 0421 759 508 or via email bsharp15@bigpond.com.au for approval and to obtain required evidence requirements for a local CAMS Scrutineer to conduct the inspection.

12. Service Park

- a) Vehicles entering or leaving the designated Service Park are to travel at walking pace (10kph Max.) and must follow directional markers.
- b) When vehicles are not competing, they must remain in the confines of the pit area for the duration of the event.
- c) All competition vehicles must be unloaded in the pit area within 30 minutes of arrival at the event site, regardless of the event commencement.
Any competition vehicle found parked outside the pit or competition areas will be removed from competition.
- d) Crews are allowed one tender vehicle in the pit area. One pit pass will be provided to the Crew Leader upon arrival and the vehicle registration will be noted. All other crew member vehicles may be parked "offsite" in the car park provided for the duration of the competition. Any vehicle moving "onsite" without an official permit may be towed to the car park. Competing vehicles must be taken directly to the pit area.
- e) Disposal of waste products including but not limited to oil, coolant, fuel and other products must be disposed of as per direction from the Key Personnel listed in section 2. Teams found not to abide by this requirement will be disqualified from the event.

13. Anti-Doping Policy

- a) During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day.
- b) Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual.
- c) In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).
- d) The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will take precedence.

14. Competition and Layout

- a) The competition will be conducted as per the schedule produced in this event pack. Please note that due to weather conditions this is subject to change with schedule changes provided on the event notice board located near the Main Eating Shelter.
- b) The competition tracks will be laid out to conform to Khanacross Regulations.
- c) Each discipline will be given its own identity.
- d) There will be a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 30 disciplines.
- e) Scoring will be based on individual times. The best individual times per team will be added together to decide the Overall Placings.
- f) The program of events will be issued on the website as part of the publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- g) Events will be timed using Rally Clocks and/or Stopwatches.
- h) Penalties will be applied in accordance with Khanacross Regulations and the National Motorkhana Code. Penalties will be made available on Rover Scout Motorsport website and on the event noticeboard located near the main eating shelter.
- i) The Clerk of Course will be the Judge of Fact for any competition matters.

- j) All timekeepers are considered Judges of Fact for any timing and penalty matters
- k) Maximum track length is 2.5km

17. Awards

- a) Awards for the competitive event:
 - a. Trophies will be awarded to Rovers; First, Second and Third O/R.
 - b. Trophies will be awarded to the First crews for each discipline.
 - c. A Trophy will be awarded to the Best Placed Non-Rover Team.
 - d. A Trophy will be awarded to the Best Performed Rookie (Aged 21 or under) Driver.
 - e. A Trophy will be awarded to the Best Performed Fillie (Female) Driver.

18. Protests

- a) Protests may be made under Part XII of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport

19. Abandonment

- a) The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59.
- b) In the advent of inclement weather conditions, competitors may contact a Key Official after 5 pm on the day before the meeting to confirm the event's status. The event will not proceed if there is a Total Fire Ban declared in the RFS district on the day.

20. Results

- a) Provisional Event results will be announced at Presentations on Sunday 11th March 2018 after 9.00pm.
- a) Full Event results will be available from the Rover Scout Motorsport website as well as by email if requested by competitors.
