1. THE EVENT

4. AUTHORITY

The Event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) Ltd, the Khanacross Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, which may be issued by RSM.

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

5. PLACE AND DATE

The Event will be held at Bagshot Motorsport Complex from Friday 27th April 2018 to Sunday 29th April 2018.

6. ENTRIES

Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close on 13th April 2018 at 5:00pm. An entry will only be deemed valid when payment is received with a completed and signed RSM entry form. Incomplete forms may be deemed as late entries at the discretion of the Clerk of Course and Event Secretary.

All Drivers must hold a CAMS level 2NS/2NSJ License or superior. A maximum of eight Drivers per vehicle will be accepted.

Entry fee is \$65 per person for entries received by 5:00pm Friday 13th April 2018. An additional late entry fee of \$25 per driver will apply for entries received after 5:00pm 13th April 2018 until 5:00pm 20th April 2018. No entries will be accepted after 5:00pm 20th April 2018.

A maximum number of 100 entries will apply. Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

7. DRIVERS SIGN IN

Teams will be assigned a time slot for sign in and vehicle Scrutiny from 8:30am on Saturday 28th April. All Competitors/Drivers must present their current CAMS License to the paperwork checker at the Secretary's desk during their allocated time slot. Teams who have information missing from their entry form may be assigned a later time slot. All team members must present together at their allocated time slot, teams who miss their time will be assigned the next available time slot.

See section 8. Scrutiny for more information about the sign in / Scrutiny process.

8. SCRUTINY

Scrutiny will be at the Bagshot Motorsport Complex. Scrutiny will commence at 8:30am on Saturday 28th April.

Teams will be assigned a time slot for sign in and vehicle scrutiny based on the size of their team. All team members must present together at their allocated time, teams who miss their time will be assigned the next available time slot. A representative must remain with the vehicle while in the lineup. Two team members must present at scrutiny in full race attire. Once sign in and scrutiny is complete, teams will be assigned a track and may proceed to race.

Vehicle Log Book (if issued) & competition attire for all drivers must be presented with vehicle. Apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

9. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

All competing vehicles must comply with Schedules A and B of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and RSM Standing Regulations.

10. DRIVERS BRIEFING

Drivers Briefing for the day session will be in the form of a written Briefing to be read at sign in. Any specific information about the tracks will be passed on by the time keeper at the start gate.

Driver Briefing for the night track will commence at 6:30pm on Saturday 28th April.

11. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au

12. CLASSES:

A: Rovers

B: Other RSM Members (Non-Rovers)

ROOKIES: Any driver 21 years and under on the day of competition or any driver who has held a CAMS License for the first time for less than 12 months

LADIES: Any female regardless of age

13. SPECIAL NOTES

- Any breaches of these Supplementary Regulations will be dealt with in the same manner as a breach of all other regulations pertaining to the Event.
- Competitors must have two members in the vehicle during competition. Both members must hold a L2NS or superior CAMS license.
- Traveling speed away from the competition area will be walking pace only, this includes approaching and leaving start and stop garages.
- Fire extinguishers as per Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport must be securely fitted to the vehicle.
- Safety helmets must conform to CAMS requirements (eg AS 1698) and be worn whilst competing.
- All Competitors are required to wear snug fitting clothes covering the body from neck to wrist to ankles and suitable footwear. Clothing should be of a fire resistant nature.
- Penalties as per Khanacross Regulations.
- No vehicle is to be started before 8:00am. All cars must be off by 10:15pm.
- All crews must provide two members for marshalling duty over the weekend. Marshall Nominations must be completed and returned to the Event Secretary with the entry form.
- Vehicles must be clean and no foreign plant or earth matter must enter Bagshot Motorsport Complex. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the event.

14. COURSE

The course surface is dirt/gravel. A minimum of 6 and a maximum of 22 tests will be conducted. The Khanacross course shall apply to that individual path and combination of maneuvers, as per Khanacross requirements, in the prescribed manner.

15. RUNNING DETAIL

Khanacross results will be calculated on the total of elapsed times to complete the tests nominated by the director and any penalties. The winner shall be the driver/crew having the lowest total. Timing will be by handheld stopwatches or other means.

16. TERMINATION

The Organisers reserve the right to stop the Event at any time if they consider it necessary, in the interests of safety or for any other reason.

17. POSTPONEMENT OR ABANDONMENT

The Organizers reserve the right to postpone, abandon, or cancel the Event under NCR 59, and if the event is cancelled or postponed for more than 24 hours, the entry fees shall be refunded in full.

18. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st placed Rover for each discipline, Best Performed Rookie, Best Performed Female, Outright 1st placed Non-Rover team, Outright 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed Rover teams.

19. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

20. NOISE

Vehicles must be ADEQUATELY muffled and not exceed a noise limit of 95dB(A).

21. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

22. FUEL

Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

 - others participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
 - high levels of noise exposure;
 - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
 - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

 howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;
- to **indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified** the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
