1. Name

The name of the series shall be the 'Rover Scout Motorsport Championship Series' or 'RSM Championship' for short.

2. Committee

- a) The RSM Championship Series is administered by the Rover Scout Motorsport Club Executive including delegates of the Event Teams that run Championship Events. Decisions regarding the Championship, its administration and rules will be made by the RSM Executive.
- b) The role of Series Co-ordinator is held by the RSM Training & Development Officer
- c) RSM Chairman is recommended to sign on as the CRO (Competitor Relation Officer) upon arrival at an event. (To assist competitors with navigating the world of CAMS and the club)

4. Events

- a) Number of Rounds
The series shall consist of a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of six (6) Rounds. The number of Rounds will be determined by RSM and the Series Co-ordinator.
- b) Eligible Events
The eligible events for Championship will be determined by the Series Co-ordinator in consultation with the RSM Committee.
- c) Requirements for Championship Rounds:
 - a. Compliance with the RSM Standing Regulations, RSM Policies and RSM Event Minimum Operating Standards.
 - b. The following line in the Event Supplementary Regulations: *This event is also round # for the club level Rover Scout Motorsport Championship Series 20XX/XX.*
 - c. Release of Provisional Results is required within **one two** weeks of the event and Final Results two weeks later. Championship Points will not be calculated until Final Results are received.
- d) Conditions for Uncontested Series
Less than three (3) events shall not constitute a Series. In such instance the Series shall be declared as '**NOT CONTESTED**' for that year.
- e) Failure to Run
If an event is marked as a Championship round and not run, each crew will receive zero for that round.

5. Eligibility

- a) All Rover Crews that compete in RSM Sanctioned Events are eligible to receive Championship Points.
- b) Non-Rover teams are ineligible to receive Championship Points
- c) To be eligible for the Championship placing's and subsequent prizes (trophies), teams must attend and start in a minimum of two (2) Championship Rounds.
- d) Entrants to the Championship are on a per team (i.e. crew) basis. For crews with multiple vehicles or entries to the event, points will be awarded to each vehicle, with the highest point scoring vehicle being recognised as the championship entry
- e) If a car is written off at an event it can be replaced with an entire new car not already in the championship and points carried on.
- f) Teams must be made up of Registered Rovers. ~~(RA's included)~~ **(RA's times can be included as part of a Rover team entry in tests designated as RA's only)**
- g) **Membership will be determined at census time and rovers who turn 26 during the championship will still be considered rovers for the remainder of the championship series.**

5. Awards

- a) The Series Championship shall be determined by the aggregate of points scored for event performances as per Rule 6.
- b) Championship awards shall be:
 - Outright 1st
 - Outright 2nd
 - Outright 3rd

6. Series Point Scoring System

- a) Points will be awarded to teams for Overall Event Placing's at each event as follows:
 - 1st – 50
 - 2nd – 48
 - 3rd – 46
 - And so on...
 - Down to: 20th - 12.

10 points will be awarded to all crews that place lower than 20th Overall.

- b) Points from each Round shall be tallied together to give a Championship Ranking.
- c) The series shall conclude each year at Mudbash.

7. Other Awards

- a) Clubman Award - awarded to a Rover who has displayed exceptional sportsmanship which promotes and positively enhances Rover Scout Motorsport.
- b) Club Official Award - awarded to a non-senior official (e.g. not Clerk of Course, Steward or Director) for large participation and displaying fairness and sportsmanship within Rover Scout Motorsport
- c) Nominations for these awards are set out in separate guidelines.
